Women's rights are the fundamental human rights.

The Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) was proposed in Congress in 1923 to secure full equality for women. The ERA seeks to end legal distinctions between men and women.



Voting Rights

The 19th Amendment was ratified in 1920, which makes it illegal to deny the right to vote to any citizen based on their gender, which effectively granted women the right to vote.

Equal Pay

The Equal Pay Act of 1963, amending the Fair Labor Standards Act, protects against wage discrimination based on gender.

Property Ownership

The Fair Housing Act of 1968 prohibited discrimination in housing based on gender.

Education

Title IX is federal law that was passed in 1972. It prohibits gender discrimination in education.
